- By law, at least 90% of all tax credit dollars must be awarded as scholarships to students attending private schools.

2017 Limits

You will receive a dollar-for-dollar tax credit on your Arizona income tax return up to the amount of your income tax, or the amount of your donation, whichever is less.

The law allows a carry-over of any unused portions of the credit for up to five years.

Donations are applied to the "Original Individual Tax Credit" until the donor reaches their "tax credit limit" for the tax year. At that time, the excess dollars are applied to the new "Switcher Individual Tax Credit" until that credit is also maxed for the tax year.

Original Individual Tax Credit (Claimed on Arizona Form 323)

- Donors that file married filing jointly, for income tax purposes, can take a tax credit up to \$1,090. (2017 – \$1,092)
- Donors that do not file married filing jointly, for income tax purposes, can take a tax credit up to \$545. (2017 – \$546)

Switcher Individual Tax Credit (Claimed on Arizona Form 348)

- Donors that file married filing jointly, for income tax purposes, can take a tax credit up to \$1,083. (2017 – \$1,085)
- Donors that do not file married filing jointly, for income tax purposes, can take a tax credit up to \$542. (2017 – \$543)

Donations are used for tuition grants for K-12 students attending private schools in Arizona. Tuition grants are awarded without regard to the student's race, color, gender, handicap, familial status or national origin. At least ninety percent of the donated funds are used for tuition grants. Decisions awarding tuition grants are the sole responsibility of the association. Admission decisions are the exclusive responsibility of the school. Donations must be postmarked or delivered to the association by April 15 to be claimed as a credit for the tax year. Donations made between January 1 and April 15 may be used as a credit for the current tax year or the previous tax year but not both. They may only be used as a federal deduction in the actual year the donation was made.
